
To that end, they have been steadily working towards a project to champion those they admire. That project is Nella Folla.

No Comply is a celebration of skateboarding and its unique community. Cat & Andy craft from their workshop based in Dundee, turning broken skateboards and locally sourced reclaimed hardwood into unique, hand-crafted pieces.

Each piece carries its own story, inspired by skateboarding culture and a commitment to sustainable design.

They produce small batches of homeware and jewellery products – each with their own unique colourways – and take on commissions of all shapes and sizes. By the time No Comply get their hands on the skateboards, they have already endured a life on the street or in the park. The aim is to ensure the boards generate more memories and enjoyment in a whole new form.



Orla Stevens is an artist and illustrator, exploring nature, landscape, and how connections with the natural world make us feel.

Rooted in painting, Orla loves creating all sorts of things that help us connect to nature; from paintings, to illustrated activity books, murals, videos on YouTube and through her teaching.




CLOD & P


BoxLove, launched in 2020, enables people to send a thoughtful "hug in the post" whilst also supporting other local businesses.



From traditional scents such as Fresh Linen, to the wonderfully scottish themed candles like Irn Bru and Shortbread, there's a scent for everyone.




Andrew Barr is a writer, illustrator and map-maker based in Edinburgh. He views maps as a means to explore different aspects of geography, history and culture.



Kelda's work is centred around material connection, and the physical act of making. Using hollow forming techniques in conjunction with high pressure embossing to create tactile, enticing pieces – highlighting textures and details.

The softness of the pushed metal and the misleading perception of weight heightens curiosity and longs to be picked up.







